  - Parish Photo Directory Update (by Steve Graham)
    - Sharon found typos 2 proofs back they missed things we marked should be 95% done.
    - Dissemination plan: pick up & check off tables at the back of the Masses a couple of weekends.
    - 20% directories are given "free" for our use).
  - St. Margaret School's 50th Anniversary (1963-2013) Ideas:

### School Fundraisers Update (Deacon Nick)

  - Goal = 200 tickets sold this year.
  - Ads in FaceBook, GloucesterCounty Times, Star Herald, etc.
  - Families get 50% towards fundraising goal

- Gala Auction
  - 3/22 At Aulettos has been a sold out event only 35 tables. last year turned people away
  - This year's Goal = 100K Net.

  - Popular Teachers Table 1st time last year Movie outing or Guitar lessons or lunch@ Chick Fil-A, or Scrapbook & pool party, etc.(with a teacher)

- **Open House** 11/10/13 from 11:00am -1:00pm
  - We have a healthy enrollment. Avg =55 students/class.

- Feedback all positive. Methodist group attended wants advertizing to noncatholics next year. Bishop attended. Large interest @ ministry tables.
- 350 attended "on the ground." + 50 @ Bounce House + Ministry Tables = 400 total people!
- Perfect weather, "Wholesome event" (for a church to do) Networking, Suppoting, Sharing, Getting to know fellow Catholics in an unstructured environment they can call "home". People looking forward to next year's festival.
- This year sponsored by King's Men and made possible by an anonymous donor (please keep them in prayer)

- Hoping next year to have sponsorship to local businesses. Business were interested but funds already allocated (they must know a year in advance)
- Thanks to Kingsmen for pulling it all together so quickly and efficiently. A new group of men meeting for only 1.5 yrs - leaders, protectors, providers trying to be holier - this FESTIVAL was the outlet.
