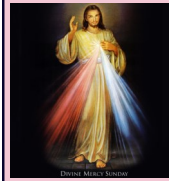

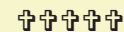

Dear Friends in Christ,



As we conclude the Octave of Easter, the Church celebrates the Sunday of Divine Mercy. What a beautiful feast day that celebrates the bathing of our souls in the mercy and love of the Lord. In her diary, Saint Faustina reported her that anyone who attends Mass and receives the sacraments of Penance and Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday is assured by Jesus of full remission of their sins and punishments. What a magnificent grace! If that were not enough, the one who brought this devotion to the forefront of the Church will be canonized this weekend, namely Pope John Paul II along with Pope John XXIII. Pope John Paul II once said, "Apart from the mercy of God, there is no other source of hope for mankind." These times certainly can cloud one's spirit, but we know that all is well if we pray the motto of the Divine Mercy: Jesus, I trust in Thee!" I cannot but feel close to these two popes, now recognized as saints. I was born under the reign of Pope Saint John XXIII and I studied for the Holy Priesthood, was ordained and served sixteen years as a priest during the reign of Pope Saint John Paul II. Pope John Paul II came to the world from Poland which suffered for the faith and he brought a new sense of hope to the world in instructing us straightaway after his election: "Do not be afraid!" I once read that one of his secretaries would, when planning Pope John Paul's itinerary for a trip, request that the route avoid going near a chapel with the Blessed Sacrament or to have a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Not out of any lack of devotion, but it would delay the whole day, because the Holy Father could not resist an unplanned visit to the chapel or to stop and pray with the Madonna. This sums up so much about the wonderful John Paul II: Jesus and Mary. The Mass was his strength and Our Lady his mother. I can only take comfort to have been in the presence of the likes of John Paul II and Mother Teresa of Calcutta. May our newly canonized popes inspire us to do great things for the Lord, loving the Lord with our whole being with the assistance of our Blessed Lady. Pope Saints John XXIII and John Paul II, pray for us! Happy Divine Mercy Sunday!

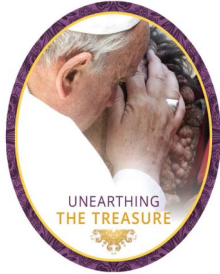

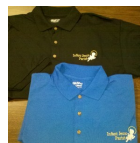
