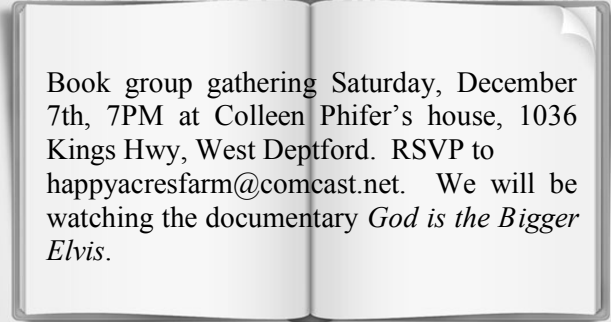
**Rosary For The Unborn-

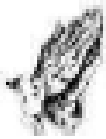
