

#### Dear Friends in Christ,

From the Every once in awhile, one may see a movie star or sports player asked in an interview as to what he or she does on a Sunday. It is the rarity that one reads that they go to Mass or church (unless they are Mark Wahlberg). They will speak of daddy making omelets or settling down to watch a game or to go to the park for a stroll. Nothing about God! It would seem that should someone be paid unbelievable amounts of money to play a character on film or to play a game would be extremely grateful to God for the talent and opportunities they have been given. It is sad to hear when we choose a football game or party over being with the Lord in His house. We can fool ourselves in believing that what we are doing is more important than God, but we are lying to ourselves. Blessed John Paul II gave us an historical insight, "When, during the persecution of Diocletian, their assemblies were banned with the greatest severity, many were courageous enough to defy the imperial decree and accepted death rather than miss the Sunday Eucharist. This was the case of the martyrs of Abitina, in Proconsular Africa, who replied to their accusers: "Without fear of any kind we have celebrated the Lord's Supper, because it cannot be missed; that is our law"; "We cannot live without the Lord's Supper". (Dies Domini, John Paul II, 1998). This past Sunday, during the snowstorm, a small group of the faithful attended the 4:00 PM Mass in our chapel. Despite the weather, they wanted to be with the Lord; they saw the importance of being with Jesus to celebrate the Pascal Mystery. Obviously, one should not risk their safety, but I was edified. My heart aches when children say that they cannot attend Mass because their parents are busy. I hope that a parent is not too busy to cook a dinner for a child or to read them a bedtime story. What could be more important that teaching a son or daughter to love God and worshipping in the pew next to them? Advent is about renewing our faith in Jesus and having Him come alive in our souls. It will not happen without *living* the faith, *living* Jesus in the Holy of Holies.
