Dear Friends in Christ,

According to Latin missionary accounts sent back to Manila, a wonderful saint declared ρ_{astor} these words upon his death: "Ego Catholicus sum et animo prompto paratoque pro Deo

mortem obibo. Si mille vitas haberem, cunctas ei offerrem." In English this may be rendered: "I am a Catholic and wholeheartedly do accept death for the Lord; If I had a thousand lives, all these I shall offer to Him." This may have been offered in Tagalog or Filipino as: "Isa akong Katoliko at buong-pusong tinatanggap ang kamatayan para sa Panginoon. Kung ako man ay may isanlibong buhay, lahat ng iyon ay iaalay ko sa Kanya." As we stand in utter horror at the suffering of the Filipino people because of the typhoon, we see a beacon of hope from this beautiful, very Catholic country that has given a great deal to the Church and even to our parish. Saint Lorenzo Ruiz, quoted above, died for the faith. He died a horrible death at the hands of the Japanese to whom he had gone to be a missionary. Wikipedia recounts that on 27 September 1637, Ruiz and his companions were taken to the Nishizaka Hill, where they were tortured by being hung upside down over a pit. This form of torture was known as tsurushi in Japanese. The method was supposed to be extremely painful: though the victim was bound, one hand is always left free so that victims may be able to signal that they recanted, and they would be freed. Ruiz would not renounce Christianity and died from blood loss and suffocation. His body was cremated and his ashes thrown into the sea. He was canonized as a martyr for the faith on the 18th of October (two days after the feast day of Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque!) and his feast day is celebrated on September 28th. This typhoon reminds us how our lives can change in an instant and that we must always live fully in the Lord each day. Jesus is the one constant and we must refrain from putting Him off for another day. May St. Lorenzo pray for the great Filipino people! Santo Nino have mercy on them!


The Show is at 1:00pm (and will run until 2:30pm) - buses will leave NYC at 5pm for a return approximately 7:15pm.




