Bishop Sullivan has declared this weekend: *Vocation to the Diocesan Priesthood Sunday*. He said in a letter to the priests of the diocese, "I want our faithful to hear from you that the Lord is calling young men to the priesthood for the Church in Camden." Father King and I will therefore share our own gift of the Lord's calling to the Priesthood. We want to share the joys of being a priest with you this weekend. So many blessings are taking place in our parish, but I continue to beg the Lord to give a beautiful sign to Infant Jesus Parish in having men step forward to give their lives in service of the one, true God. 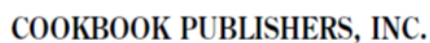
