


Dear Friends in Christ,

Bishop Sullivan has encouraged parishes to have an increased giving campaign at this time and the diocese is willing to subsidize a portion of the fee of the company carrying



out the work. After meeting with our Finance Council, we have chosen a company called Cunneen. They have been successful in aiding parishes in capital campaigns and other increased giving programs. Infant Jesus is not conducting a capital campaign, but rather, we will be encouraging everyone to assess what they give to their spiritual home and to perhaps consider adding more to that amount each week. We have come a long way since our merger and now, with your help, we will be in a position to improve our church properties, churches and the rectory offices for greater efficiency and welcome. 
