Dear Friends in Christ,

It is with sadness, yet with hope in the resurrection that our parish of Infant Jesus prays for ρ_{astor} the eternal rest of Monsignor David F. Budney, former pastor of Saint Margaret Parish.



Monsignor died this past week and will be buried from Infant Jesus Parish, Saint Margaret Church, on Wednesday, April 9th. His viewing will be held in Saint Margaret Church from 9:00 AM until 11:00 AM when a Mass of Christian Burial will be offered. He will then be taken for internment to Hawthorne, New York. Monsignor Budney was pastor of Saint Margaret's from 1973 until 1985. Monsignor built the section of the school that is known as the Budney Wing and even more importantly, Monsignor oversaw the building of Saint Margaret Church dedicated in 1978. Monsignor would serve as the Vicar General of the Diocese of Camden. While I did not know Monsignor Budney very well, I did have to meet with him a few times and found him friendly with a kind smile. He was a shy man who carried out his priestly duties without seeking adulation. He was a faithful priest of the Diocese of Camden and served at a time when the diocese was expanding. We priests who are left behind pray that we will carry out the Lord's work with the same steadfast commitment to the faith as the priests of old. As he is a very important part of the history of Infant Jesus Parish, I call upon all the faithful to pray for Monsignor Budney, that he would now rest in peace with Jesus Christ, the High Priest whose call Monsignor Budney answered so long ago.




