BUTEMBO SENATUS: 468 people were baptised and 11 Protestants were converted as were Moslems.

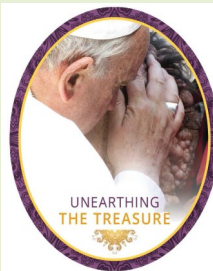

RCIA

We - both clergy and laity - as disciples of Jesus Christ in Infant Jesus Parish all share a common twofold mission: to be faithful followers of Jesus and to then "Go, therefore, and make disciples." Often what *you* can do, no one else can.
