This Monday, we celebrate the Feast of Saint John Vianney, one of the patrons of Infant Jesus Parish. We will honor him at a Mass that will be on Monday, August 4th at 7:00



PM, followed be refreshments in the Vianney Center. Come out to honor this miracle of God. Saint John is the patron of priests and is a model for all those who wish to advance in the faith. When Saint John arrived at Ars, France as a priest, it was a dead parish with the faith hardly being practiced. The Cure of Ars would embark a program that was simple, yet effective in bringing souls to Christ. The Sacrament of Penance was paramount to his ministry as he spent sixteen to eighteen hours a day in the confessional. His direction for people exemplified common sense, remarkable insight and supernatural knowledge. He was tortured by the devil (always a sign of holiness...so take heart at being tortured by temptation. The devil is afraid you may become more saintly!). Saint John also mortified himself in a very strong way. He lived on potatoes and water and never got enough sleep, yet he was always cheerful and pleasant. All of us, clergy and lay people alike, can learn from him to love the Holy Faith, adore the Most Blessed Sacrament, go to confession frequently, do penance and accept the difficulties of life with a smile. We can forget the excuses as Saint John Marie Vianney once said, "We will either accuse ourselves or excuse ourselves."



We will be collecting school supplies such as new or gently used backpacks, note books, folders, pens, pencils, crayons, etc. throughout July and August for needy


