Dear Friends in Christ,

In Saint Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians (3:15), he writes, "Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith; examine yourselves! Or do you not recognize this about yourselves that Jesus Christ is in your unless indeed you fail the test?" Would we pass the test? Are we



selves that Jesus Christ is in you – unless indeed you fail the test?" Would we pass the test? Are we truly men and women of faith? How often we can take our faith for granted! I do not think you would be reading this bulletin letter were you not a believer. There are many who find the faith intriguing though not having been born into it. Some people, sitting in the pew next to us, may not be a Roman Catholic, yet they attend Mass regularly. It is fascinating to see people who are of another Christian denomination or not even baptized more faithful than those raised in the faith. One of the reasons that the RCIA program is so public is because it also is meant to remind all of us that we must choose to follow Jesus every day. It is not a one shot deal, but each day that the Lord gives us the opportunity to say to Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go, You alone have the words of eternal life." I will follow! This year, once again, people will present themselves to begin the process of becoming Catholic. The Lord will put in their heart the desire to embrace the "fullness of the faith." At first, they may want to become Catholic for their future spouse, a husband or wife, for their children. After time, they will see how much they have been missing. O, the glory of the Mass and the reception of Holy Communion! If you know someone who is not Catholic pray for them and encourage them to enter the one, true faith. What a wondrous blessing to be Catholic We should pray for the conversation of all. The great English martyr, Saint Margaret Clitherow as she was being pressed to death for being a Catholic "was to pray aloud for the Catholic Church, the Pope, and especially for Elizabeth [the first], Queen of England, that God turn her [Elizabeth] to the Catholic faith. For I wish as much good to Her Majesty's soul as to my own". As she died Margaret cried out: "Jesu, Jesu, have mercy on me!" Now, there was a woman who did not take her faith for granted.

God bless you, Father Szolack




