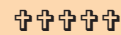


**FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION

Dear Friends in Christ,



Bishop Sullivan is celebrating the Mass at 10:00 AM in Saint Margaret Church this weekend. This is the annual Mass for New Candidates for the Seminary. The seminarians will leave after a luncheon to begin their diocesan retreat before they prepare to leave for the seminary. It is always special to have our diocesan shepherd with us. The Bishop wants to highlight priestly and religious vocations in the parishes. We have a long way, with still much to do, in our parish. My one frustration is that we have not had anyone enter the seminary from Infant Jesus Parish. We clearly have a community of faith. The Lord is still calling men to enter priestly ministry for He will never leave us abandoned, but He does not force anyone to answer affirmatively. There are many clouds on the horizon in this world and many people will be turning to the Lord. We desperately need men to step up to be prepared to help people find salvation in Christ through the Holy Mass, confessions and preaching the Word of God. We need our Catholic faith so very much. Where would we be without the Mass and the reception of Holy Communion? Dare we walk around steeped in sin because there is no one to absolve us of our sins in the name of the Lord? Who will anoint the sick and bury the dead? We need strong men to apply to do the Lord's bidding, no matter the cost (thus, weaklings need not apply!). If you are a man who knows in his heart that you have a special mission and want to give your life to something powerful and glorious, come and speak to one of your priests. I thank the Lord every day that He called me to be a priest. Having no idea what I was called to at first, now having served for a quarter of a century, I have no regrets, but only a heart filled with gratitude for the gift of a priestly vocation. St. John Chrysostom says, that "though its functions are performed on earth, the priesthood should be numbered among the things of Heaven." There is much work to do. Let's go men, Jesus calls out to you!

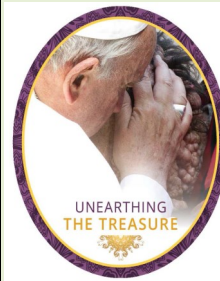

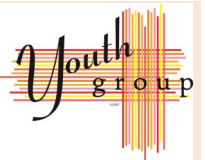
