On the weekend of the 20-21st of December, our parish, dedicated to the Infant Jesus, Paster invites you to bring the baby Jesus figurines from your nativity sets to church for us to



bless. Pope Benedict spoke of this custom saying we are all called to "try to live in the everyday reality of what Christ's Nativity represents, which is the love of Christ, his humility and his poverty." The little figurines we will bring to Mass are made of porcelain, clay, wood or resin. Bishop Sullivan is hosting a tour of Ireland departing Philadelphia Saturday, July 18th and returning to Philadelphia on Wednesday, July 29th. Visit Dublin, Cavan, Armagh, Knock, Galway, the Cliffs of Mohrer. Limerick & much more. Tour includes 11 days/10 nights; ten full Irish breakfasts; ten dinners (one with Irish storytelling & entertainment); gratuities to driver/guide; porterage of one piece of luggage; four star hotels; air conditioned motor coach; and a few Irish ballads sung by the Bishop along the way. The land cost of tour is \$2209 p/p double with a \$479 single supplement; space is limited.
