Dear Friends in Christ,

We are privileged that our parish is named after our dear Savior, the Infant Jesus. Together as a faith community, we are called to prepare for something... for someone. Jesus so much wants to



be a part of our lives. How often, we are afraid of what it takes to follow Him with our "whole mind, heart and soul." When a baby is expected, everyone is preparing for a great arrival. I have always enjoyed the television show *I Love Lucy*. An enjoyable scene was Lucy, Ricky, Fred and Ethel are practicing for the moment when Lucy would go into labor, needing a ride to the hospital. All is calm until the actual event. When Lucy announces it is time, mayhem ensues. Jesus wants to be in the middle of our mayhem; we think we are prepared for Him. Are we ready for His return in glory or to have Him change our lives? How easy it is to prepare for Christmas, for a mere time of remembrance. We can cling to customs, believing that they are what Christmas is all about. There are some little witnesses in the Middle East who revealed true love for the Christ. The terrorist group Isis told some little ones whom they were preparing to behead, "Convert to Islam or be killed." What did the young ones say? "No, we love Jesus." When I read this in the paper, my eyes filled up. Do we love Jesus? Too often, we deny Him for a penny! These little martyrs flew to Jesus like shooting stars! The Scriptures say "... And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony about Jesus and because of the word of God. 
