Dear Friends in Christ,

Pastor The Church dedicates the month of February to the Holy Family. In the Bible we see in Proverbs 3:33, "The Lord will put a curse on the evil person's house, but He will bless the home of people who do what is right." What does it mean to "do what is right?" The Holy Family is the model of doing what is right. Our Lady, Saint Joseph and Our Savior, Jesus, lived the Covenant with God totally and lovingly despite the cost. It takes a lot of hard work for a man and woman to sacrifice so much of their life for their children. How does a family live their baptismal promises to God? Faithfully attending Holy Mass; receiving Holy Communion in a state of grace, thus going to confession; reading and meditating on the Bible; and living the moral teachings of the faith. Do we allow trash to enter our homes through televisions and computers or do we block it out? Is our language offensive and demeaning to God and to the members of our family? Do we speak ill of others giving bad example? Do we make family life a priority by giving members our time and energy? I heard a young widower speaking on the radio about his children. He said he is so proud of his three children and is proud of himself because he worked hard to give them a good home. They didn't have a lot of things because he couldn't work two jobs as he needed to be sure to have dinner on the table every night and he insisted everyone eat together. Everyone talked about their day. Cell phones and other electronics were forbidden at the table (he said they still are in his house when speaking to each other). The TV was never on while they ate. Even their sports and other activities took second place to dinner. The man said that if you don't get the kids during the middle school years, they will not be gotten. Finally, he said, "WE NEVER MISSED MASS." I am not naïve enough to believe there is an easy formula to raising a family, but traditional seems to be a bad word today...what a shame.
