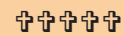

Dear Friends in Christ,



A beautiful and loving devotional posture that is being neglected or carried out sloppily is genuflection. This action is bending one knee to the floor, namely the right knee, before the Most Blessed Sacrament as well as adoring the Cross on Good Friday. A crisis in faith is reflected in the lack of awareness and reverence for the Real Presence contained in the Tabernacle. It is disturbing enough that we chat so openly and loudly in a church that houses the Holy Presence, but how often we greet the Master of the House with barely a nod (the genie in the television show, *I Dream of Jeannie*, bowed more reverently when she blinked up some magic!) or a snort in His direction. Children jump up out of their seats to use the facility (so many frantic emergencies!) even in the middle of the consecration. Frighteningly, there is no genuflection as they leap from their pew! What are we teaching them? No wonder people do not feel the need for Mass if they have no idea Who is present on the altar. Now, I need not be chastised by those who would tell me “I cannot genuflect...I have a bad knee or am advanced in age.” Obviously, they are not the ones being addressed. For the healthy, that is another matter. When I was a young seminarian, a professor said that when we entered the chapel, he wanted to “hear” our knees hit the marble floor! If we offered anything less, he accused us men of curtseying! Greet your Lord upon entering a church with love. Bend your knee to Him. Say farewell to the Real Presence on your right knee as you leave your pew. If you absolutely, cannot do so, offer a profound bow, not a nod that would not get the attention of even the most attentive. Lest you say, where do you get all this Father? Ask Saint Paul who tells us “So that at the name of Jesus *every knee should bend*, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” (Philippians 2:10-11).

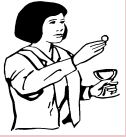

### PLEASE BRING US YOUR PALM

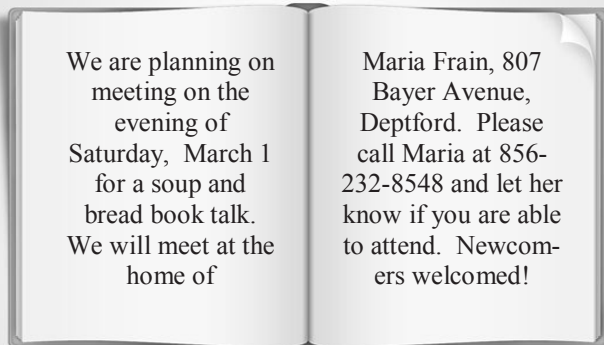
