### Dear Friends in Christ,

When at a wedding or funeral, you may hear the priest say these or similar words: "For all those Pastor 5 who are Catholic and are in a state of grace, that is a regular attendee at Mass, you may now come forward for Holy Communion." I have had people say, "Oh, that is so uninviting and unnecessary." In reality, it is for the proper reception of Holy Communion and out of charity for non-Catholic guests. When performing a wedding at Saint John Vianney Church, I saw someone sitting in the pew holding the Blessed Host. The man next to him snatched the Host and placed it in his own mouth. Upon questioning, the man who received the Host said that his friend was Jewish and simply went up and took the Holy Sacrament like the others. He did not know. The Catholic realized he needed to consume the Host. I had neglected to make the announcement I mention above. This would have saved our Jewish guest any embarrassment or confusion. Recently, a Host was found near the Saint Margaret Mary shrine. It had been partly consumed. To one's horror, who knows what went on there? A communicant should receive the Sacred Host directly on the tongue or if receiving in the hand, they should step to the side and consume the Host immediately. They should not carry the Sacrament away with them and "pop" the Host into their mouth as they walk to their seat! The Church's teaching continues to be that those who may present themselves for Holy Communion must be Catholic and in a state of grace. Otherwise, we receive Holy Communion sacrilegiously. Should one miss Mass unnecessarily or commit a mortal sin (serious matter, sufficient reflection and full consent of the will), he should confess his sins in the Sacrament of Penance before receiving. Even should a Catholic be unable to receive Holy Communion, they are still obligated to attend Holy Mass. This is the official teaching and when you hear an announcement at a wedding or funeral, please do not see it as unwelcoming and inconsiderate, but rather, charitable and respectful to the Most Blessed Sacrament, the Real Presence of Jesus.


