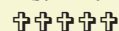

Dear Friends in Christ,

One of the hallmarks of Religious Life is obedience. Our obedience to God; for the chosen, a call to obedience to religious superiors. 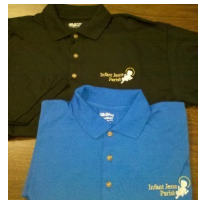

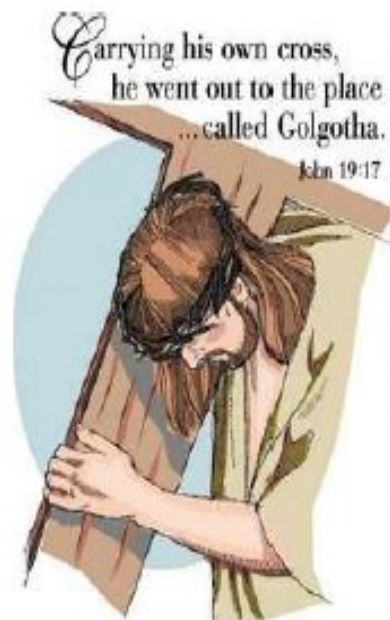
