Dear Friends in Christ,



The power of the Lenten Season is under full force. A word we hear over and over is "conversion." The etymology of the word conversion is "to turn around." But sorrowfully, this world is ever more about setting people in the wrong direction: sinful attractions, lack of prayer, rejecting the Holy Mass, refusing to confess sins and behaviors that insult the dignity we have as men and women made in the image and likeness of God. The Gospel shouts out to us, "Turn around, before it's too late!" If someone were walking towards quicksand or preparing to go over a cliff, would you not warn them? Yet, how many are choosing the road to destruction by walking further and further away from the Lord Jesus. The Lord says, "Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few." (Matthew 7:13-14). The venerable Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen offers, we are either moving towards God or away from Him...no middle ground. Half way measures are not acceptable. Billy Sunday, baseball player and evangelist once said, "Conversion is a complete surrender to Jesus. It's a willingness to do what He wants you to do." Note those words "...what He wants you to do." We can be so rebellious and immature in our self fulfilling needs, but we have living signs in our midst reminding us all about a call to conversion. Four people have persevered in our *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* program: Jena, Ryan, Josh and Michael are choosing to turn their lives over to Jesus Christ entering the fullness of the faith, the Holy Catholic Church.
