Dear Friends in Christ,



As Lent now moves into its final phase in preparation of Easter, we should look to the Passion of Our Lord to really enter into the love expressed in the past, future and present by Jesus. Our forefathers in the faith often expressed a deep devotional life and a thirst for holiness. Readings of the holy ones always include meditations on the sufferings of the Lord. Why is this so?
