

#### Dear Friends in Christ,

On Fridays during Lent, we will once again have the Stations of the Cross which are a Pastor venerable way to meditate on the Passion and Death of Our Savior. The Stations call to mind that we are on a pilgrimage. Christians would go to the Holy Land to walk the royal steps of Jesus in His agony. I have had the privilege of walking the Stations of the Cross in the streets of Jerusalem. It was so powerful to walk on the cobbled streets through the shopping district and finishing with the offering of Holy Mass on Golgotha and then also offering Mass in the Holy Sepulchre. The first church erected at the Holy Sepulchre was completed in 335 AD. As is written, "Pilgrimages eventually took a fixed route from the ruins of the Fortress Antonia, where Pilate had his judgment hall, to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. That route through Jerusalem's Old City gained acceptance as the way Jesus went to his death and remains unchanged today. It is known as the Via Dolorosa, Latin for the Sorrowful Way." After the Muslims took over the Holy Land, many sites were destroyed, but eventually the Franciscans would be the main custodians of the shrines in the Holy Land. The Holy Father would eventually give the Franciscans permission to erect the Stations of the Cross in their churches and eventually, this would spread to all churches around 1742. Saint Alphonsus Liguori would write the Stations with which we are familiar today. This ancient practice that takes us back to the holy spots in the life of our Lord should be a part of everyone's Lent. Fridays are special days to commemorate what Jesus did for us out of love. Why don't we shut off the television, put away our cellular phones, skip the mall and come to the House of the Lord to relive His act of salvation. The bulletin gives the schedule for the Stations and who will lead their celebration. We will also have confessions every Friday following the Stations of the Cross at Saint Margaret Church. Jesus asks in the Garden of Gethsemane, "Couldn't you keep watch with me for one hour?" (Matthew 26:40). That question from our Lord's lips should haunt each of us.

Keep them and comfort them in hours, of loneliness and pain, when all their life of sacrifice for souls seems but in vain.


