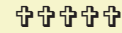

This weekend, our nation proclaims, "Happy Mothers Day!" Robert Browning wrote about Motherhood: "All love begins and ends there." During this month of Our Lady, Queen of the May, we honor mothers in our midst. I saw an article where people were asked for one word that described a mother. Some of the words were: "Funny, perfect, tenacious, inspirational, forgiving, forgiven, resilient, resolute and perfect." We know this little list barely scratches the surface. We salute all those who said yes to being a mother: biologically, adoptive and relationally. Perhaps a nanny or a teacher was a mother type to us. 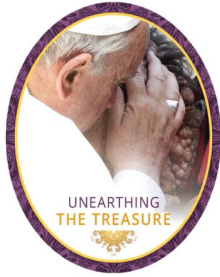

Keep them for they are in the world though from the world apart, when earthly pleasures tempt, allure, -- shelter them in Thy heart.

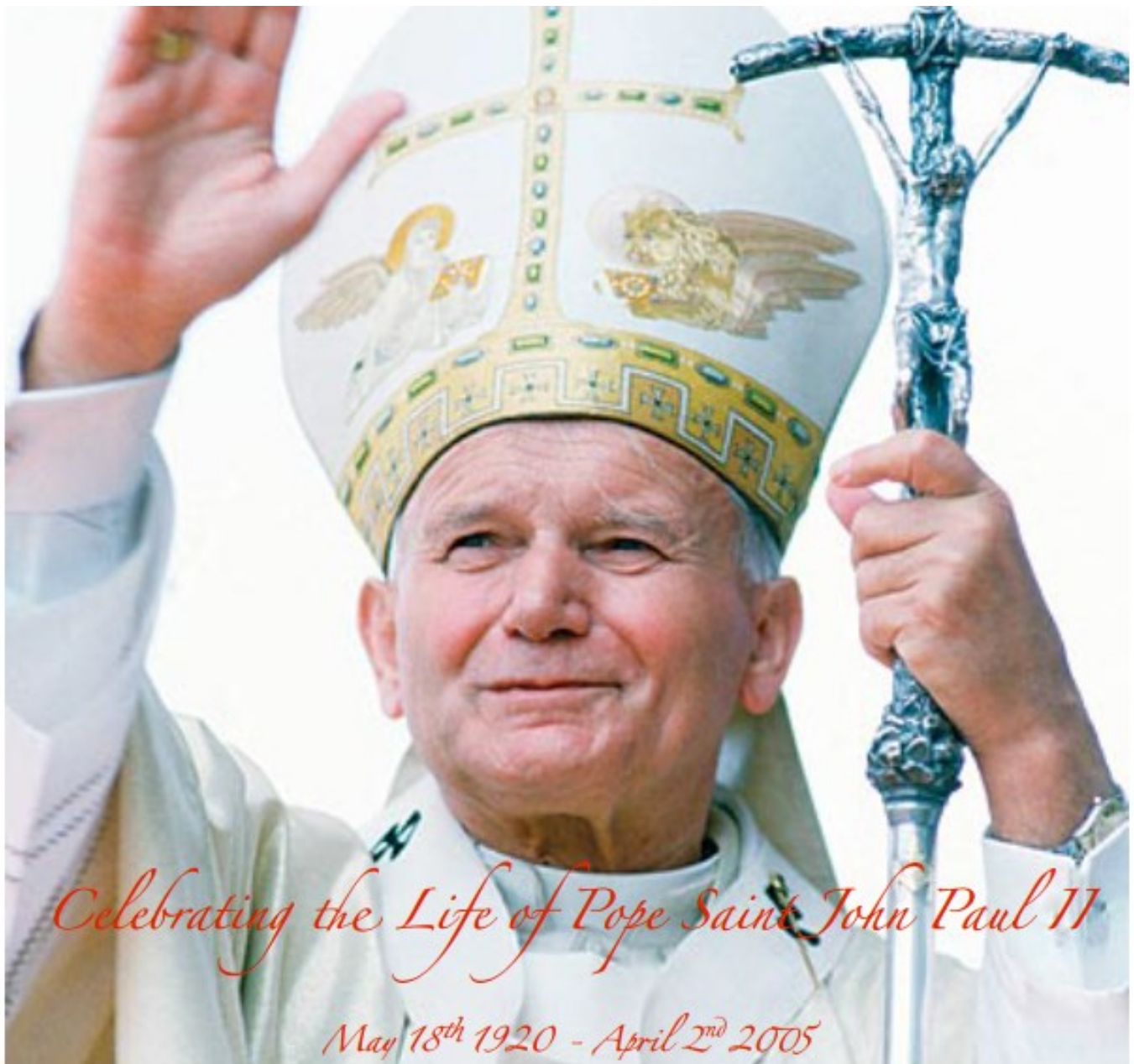
Keep them and comfort them in hours, of loneliness and pain, when all their life of sacrifice for souls seems but in vain.
