Dear Friends in Christ,

From the Pastor

This past week we prayed a beautiful Holy Hour before the Most Blessed Sacrament in praise of the Real Presence of our Lord in our midst and in reparation against the blasphemy that was to

take place at Harvard University. Through prayers and peaceful pressure, the event did not unfold as originally planned, but some still gathered in mockery of the one, true Son of God. At our hour of prayer, we praised our Lord with songs, a Gospel passage from Luke 10, along with prayers of deliverance and thanksgiving. We were crammed tightly in the chapel with people even kneeling on the floor before the Holy One. In the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, nos. 391-392, we read about the evil one: "Behind the disobedient choice of our first parents lurks a seductive voice, opposed to God, which makes them fall into death out of envy. Scripture and the Church's Tradition see in this being a fallen angel, called 'Satan' or the 'devil'. The Church teaches that Satan was at first a good angel, made by God: 'The devil and the other demons were indeed created naturally good by God, but they became evil by their own doing.' Scripture speaks of a sin of these angels. This 'fall' consists in the free choice of these created spirits, who radically and irrevocably rejected God and his reign. We find a reflection of that rebellion in the tempter's words to our first parents: 'You will be like God.' The devil 'has sinned from the beginning'; he is 'a liar and the father of lies.''' I am grateful to all who took time to praise Jesus Christ, who saves us from the foolishness of the fallen one and his minions. Praised be Jesus Christ! Now and forever!


