In these years of my pastorate at Infant Jesus Parish, I meet regularly with our Buildings and Grounds Committee. There were a number of emergency items that needed attention at both of



our properties over these years which have been attended to, but there is always so much more to do. We recently had insulation put in the ceiling of Saint John Vianney Church and we will be converting from oil to gas. The lack of insulation was extremely problematic as you would imagine. We are advised that we should see a vast improvement in savings on fuel not only over the winter, but in the summer as well. The parish offices in Woodbury Heights are in desperate need of attention. We will be configuring the offices to be more efficient for our staff, to be more welcoming to the numerous people who come to our office every day and to allow privacy for the priests and deacons when meeting with the faithful. This will include not only improving the interior of the offices, but also giving attention to the outside by fixing the disintegrating driveway, replacing rotting landscaping and making the entrance to the offices handicap accessible and more inviting. We have already removed a number of sweet gum trees in the front which drop their spiked seeds causing a hazard to walking. Please know that the priests' shared living room, kitchen, chapel and their bedrooms are not being touched. This is about improving our service to the good people of the parish, to our visitors and to those to come in their need. I am very grateful to those advising on this project and we look forward to our future enhancements on the chapel and church. I want to keep you in the loop since the rectory is your house.
