We continue to have blessed traditions at Infant Jesus Parish. Our children in second grade received Holy Communion for the first time this weekend and we have the Crowning of the Blessed



Mother at the 10:00 AM Mass. These are two special moments that highlight, above all, Jesus' desire to be an intimate part of our lives and to enjoy another one of His great gifts to mankind, His own holy Mother Mary. The entire month of May is dedicated to Our Lady who always points us to immerse ourselves in the life of Christ Families, rightfully so, celebrate the reception of Holy Communion for their children by buying them a beautiful dress or suit, they receive gifts and have cake. There is much joy in this wonderful event, but how often the bloom falls off the plant too soon. We skip Mass attending only on holidays. We choose the mundane such as sporting events over celebrating the Paschal Mystery in His house. God becomes someone we call upon in crisis, otherwise, He is of little consequence. It is odd to hear someone call themselves a devout Catholic and they do not attend Mass. The unaware say that they do not need to pray at Mass to be with God. This is true, as Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton wrote, "God is everywhere, in the very air I breathe, yes everywhere, but in His Sacrament of the Altar He is as present actually and really as my soul within my body; in His Sacrifice daily offered as really as once offered on the Cross." The crisis in the Catholic Church is the lack of belief and reverence for the Real Presence in the Most Holy Sacrament. If we knew Who was truly present at Mass, we would do anything to be in God's house. We would have vocations to the Priesthood and our churches would be full. When we face God at our death, we will be grateful for every Mass we ever attended, every Communion worthily received and we will rejoice that Mass was offered for our souls to open the gates of Heaven. This is so central to our faith, that the Church rightfully teaches that it is a mortal sin to miss Holy Mass without a good reason. May our celebration of the resurrection call us to a greater appreciation of Mass. Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you." (John 6:53). We do not need to wait to die, without the Living God, we are already dead. He alone is the antidote to death; He alone offers us the eternal life so many strive for in the dead ends of this world. He is alive and He desires this for us as well




