Dear Friends in Christ,



We now enter the holy season of Advent. It is a season of penance, thus you will note that the vesture at Mass is violet, the color of contrition. While Advent does not have the austere penance of Lent, it is still a season of preparation. Preparation in our Catholic faith calls us to examine ourselves, making new commitments and making changes in our lives. If we want the Newborn King to be reborn in our hearts, we need to make a place for Him. Too often, there is junk in our soul that needs to be discarded. We also need to take on new, fresh, healthy habits. Sinful entertainments, wasters of time, anger, resentment, etc. must be swept out. In their place must be Jesus and His Gospel. We light the first violet candle and thus, can see a bit more light in this dark world. Recent events in the world can cause a spiritual depression if we are not careful. Does prayer change anything? Why not simply enjoy life, no matter the morality? Where is God in a world that sees beheadings, terrorism, the killing of babies in the womb, a state that proposes euthanasia? The Lord Jesus is the center of all things period. The first letter of Saint Peter instructs us: "... they do not live the rest of their earthly lives for evil human desires, but rather for the will of God. For you have spent enough time in the past doing what pagans choose to do - living in debauchery, lust, drunkenness, orgies, carousing and detestable idolatry... live according to God in regard to the spirit." (1 Peter 4:2-6). The time for Jesus is now!

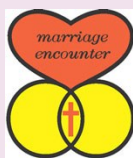
