Dear Friends in Christ,



Depression is something that afflicts a great number of people in varying degrees. Some people are plagued with serious depression that requires medication in order to function well. Thank God there is assistance for this malady. The times in which we live are certainly not helpful for anybody who is attempting to remain upbeat. No one should expect us to be Pollyanna, but the weight of our times seems to be affecting even our young people. It is bad enough that the world seems to be erupting on every level, our leadership is weak and indecisive, and it seems that we are becoming frightened by even the weather. There are the three great Theological Virtues which are fed by our spiritual life: Faith, Hope and Love. Although there are those who claim to be atheist, the majority do believe in God or in some Higher Power. And, who does not want to give and accept love? It is the virtue of hope that seems to be absent. The hopelessness brings about a mentality, "What are you going to do?" We then do nothing! Despair is the opposite of Christianity. Our sins are great, the rejection of Christ and His Gospel bring hell upon earth and our turning in on ourselves selfishly merely medicates our feelings of sadness and loss. When we are on fire with the Holy Spirit...in love with Christ...reaching for the Father, we are empowered. Jesus came to save us from our sins and He has conquered death. No matter the difficulties in this life, we keep one eye on our destiny with God. We may say, "But I want it now." We cannot fly across the room, we need to take one step at a time. Our spiritual life is the same. Consistency in attending Mass, going to confession regularly, praying before the Real Presence, saying the Rosary and spending time in meditation on Sacred Scripture – holiness – step by step. We need to plug away on weeding out sins in our life (yes, there still are things in this world that are sinful!) and giving the Lord the room to fill us with His grace, His Light. He alone lifts the darkness, the despair, the depression. A few prayers here and there will only yield a distant relationship with the Lord of Life who is all hope. The song *Flood* by Jars of Clay has some words that prayerfully express our reaching for the Lord's help: "Lift me up - When I'm falling; Lift me up - I'm weak and I'm dying; Lift me up - I need you to hold me; Lift me up - Keep me from drowning again." His arm is outstretched...let's grab His hand!

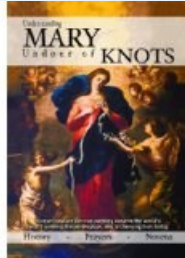
