Dear Friends in Christ,

This past Friday, the Church celebrated the feast day of Blessed Teresa of Calcutta. This Pastor extraordinary woman continues to capture the minds and hearts of many in the world

The work of the sisters and brothers who are Missionaries of Charity is to satiate the thirst of Jesus for love. I am all for fun, but I believe when we appear before Jesus, He may be more interested in how many people we loved rather than how many games we watched from our sofa. Mother Teresa reminds us so beautifully, "There is a terrible hunger for love. We all experience that in our lives – the pain, the loneliness. We must have the courage to recognize it. The poor you may have right in your own family. Find them. Love them."


Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, Washington, D.C. on Saturday, October 11, 2014.
