Dear Friends in Christ,



Queen of Heaven, rejoice. Alleluia! For the Son whom you didst merit to bear! Alleluia! He has Datar risen as He said. Alleluia! Pray for us to God. Alleluia! So, rejoice and be glad, O Blessed Virgin

Mary! Alleluia! For the Lord is truly risen! Alleluia! This beautiful prayer takes the place of the Angelus during the Easter Season and is sung at Compline or Night Prayer. Tradition holds that as the Mother of God was the first to receive God's beautiful plan at the Annunciation, she was privileged to receive news of the Resurrection of her Son by an angel. This twelfth century prayer can aid us in joyfully recalling the victory of Our Savior over sin and death. Jesus wants us to share in that victory with Him. On behalf of the priests, deacons and sisters of the parish, who are called by God to serve you, we wish you and your families a very joyful and faith filled Easter Season. This Sunday, known as Divine Mercy Sunday, we will have a special celebration of Divine Mercy that includes our parish, along with Incarnation and Holy Angel's parishes. The celebration will begin at 2:00 PM at St. Margaret Church. A plenary indulgence is granted by the usual conditions: sacramental confession (according to previously issued norms, within 20 days before or after); reception of Holy Communion; and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff (certain prayers are not specified). On Divine Mercy Sunday prayers in any church or chapel in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy or, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!") A partial indulgence is granted to the faithful who, at least with a contrite heart, pray to the merciful Lord Jesus with a legitimately approved invocation (e.g. "Jesus I trust in You. My Jesus mercy" or any other approved invocation). This beautiful expression of faith in God's mercy can bring about many graces to you and our parish. Jezu ufam Tobie! Jesus I trust in Thee! Happy Easter! Wesolego Alleluia! Buona Pasqua! Feliz Pascua! Frohe Ostern! Maligayang pasko ng pagkabuhay!
