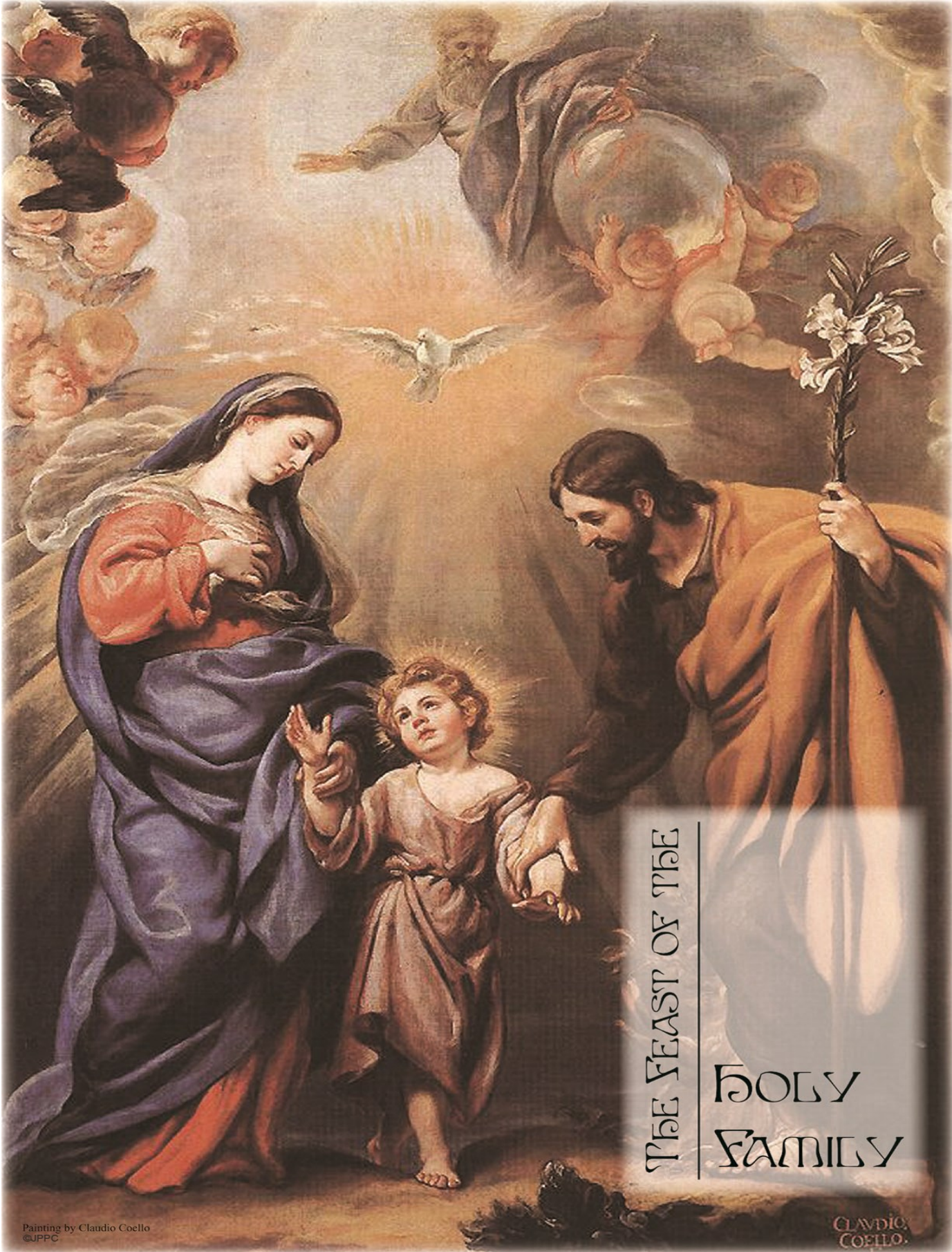

Dear Friends in Christ,



This weekend the Church honors the Holy Family. The closeness of the Holy Family is a model for us all. We belong to a larger family of faith, but are challenged to form our families into a domestic Church. The Body of Christ in our very homes. God puts us in a family which is not always perfect, yet it is from our families that we learn so much and become what we are. St. John Paul II spoke of the family many times during his rich papacy. The Holy Father said, "Thus the little domestic Church, like the greater Church, needs to be constantly and intensely evangelized: hence its duty regarding permanent education in the faith...the family, like the Church, ought to be a place where the Gospel is transmitted and from which the Gospel radiates...the future of evangelization depends in great part on the Church of the home." How many people truly learn the faith at their mother's knees! As we know, we "cannot give what we do not have." Do we have Jesus in our hearts? Is he a stranger? What are we giving our young people? A Catholic in name only is very sad. Jesus has made everything possible for us and yet we think a life with Him is optional or worse, unimportant. Our homes must become sanctuaries of Catholicism, the true faith and be a place where God is invoked and lived. Living a vibrant, Catholic faith is powerful and is actually that for which the world thirsts! Let us live our faith full of the light and joy of the Holy Spirit!

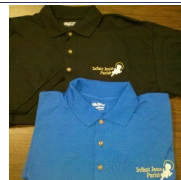
