

Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend the Church honors the Holy Family. The closeness of the Holy Family is a model for us all. We belong to a larger family of faith, but are challenged to form our families into a domestic Church. The Body of Christ in our very homes. God puts us in a family which is not always perfect, yet it is from our families that we learn so much and become what we are. St. John Paul II spoke of the family many times during his rich papacy. A Catholic in name only is very sad. Jesus has made everything possible for us and yet we think a life with Him is optional or worse, unimportant. Our homes must become sanctuaries of Catholicism, the true faith and be a place where God is invoked and lived. Living a vibrant, Catholic faith is powerful and is actually that for which the world thirsts! Let us live our faith full of the light and joy of the Holy Spirit!
