Dear Friends in Christ,



On December 8th, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, the Holy Father, Pope Francis has called for the beginning of the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy. The Holy Father wrote *Misericordie Vultus* announcing the Jubilee. In #3 in the document he writes, “The Holy Year will open on 8 December 2015, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. This liturgical feast day recalls God’s action from the very beginning of the history of mankind. After the sin of Adam and Eve, God did not wish to leave humanity alone in the throes of evil. And so he turned his gaze to Mary, holy and immaculate in love (cf. *Eph* 1:4), choosing her to be the Mother of man’s Redeemer. When faced with the gravity of sin, God responds with the fullness of mercy. Mercy will always be greater than any sin, and no one can place limits on the love of God who is ever ready to forgive. I will have the joy of opening the Holy Door on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. On that day, the Holy Door will become a *Door of Mercy* through which anyone who enters will experience the love of God who consoles, pardons, and instills hope.” We will be hearing a lot about mercy and its various expressions during this year. The Holy Year will close on November 20, 2016 on the Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Let us look forward to experiencing God’s mercy and extending mercy to others. December 8th is a Holy Day of Obligation and as Our Lady is in the forefront of all things concerning Our Lord, it is only right that her beautiful feast day kick off an extraordinary year of grace.

CLASSROOM HIGHLIGHT

Mrs. Carolynn Noonan - Kindergarten

Mrs. Noonan has taught at St. Margaret Regional School for 31 years. Her favorite subject is math. Mrs. Noonan enjoys teaching the foundational skills of geometry to her young students. They learn and differentiate flat figures and solid figures. She helps her students construct three dimensional paper figures to expand this concept with a hands-on activity. Mrs. Noonan also enjoys teaching pre-reading skills using sound rhythms. Sometimes the students use clapping, jumping or rhythm sticks to march in-time to the sound rhythms of words. During the month of December, Mrs. Noonan introduces the Advent Wreath. She explains the colored candles and how to light them each week leading up to Christmas. She sets up an empty manger in her classroom. Each day, she moves Mary and Joseph closer to the manger until they finally arrive just before the students leave for Christmas Break.
