Dear Friends in Christ,

Fastor

This weekend, our Second Graders celebrated their First Penance. This special moment for them allowed their parents and friends present to see the joy of having one's sins forgiven.

It is amazing how our young people can articulate that they have made mistakes. Regretfully, we can lose this ability as we grow older. We can blame others or convince ourselves that we are not at fault. The Sacrament of Penance is such a gift from God. I know that many will say they do not need an intermediary between them and God. Why go to a priest? I will say that I am sorry directly too Him? All of the Sacraments fulfill the traditional definition of a sacrament offered to us: "A sacrament is an outward sign instituted by Christ to give grace." Each sacrament has its tangible aspect to allow us to experience on all levels the love of the Lord. Water in baptism, chrism and laying on of hands for confirmation or the vows for marriage are sensate expressions, whether feeling, hearing or seeing. Naming our sins and expressing sorrow is the path to have Jesus tell you through the priest that your sins are forgiven. Who would deny that they need grace? We *hope* we are forgiven when we ask; we *know* we are forgiven when we go to confession. Personally, I like surety. "Then He breathed on them and said: 'Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive men's sins, they are forgiven them; if you hold them bound, they are held bound." (John 20:22-23). These are the words of Christ. Do not deny this gift from the Lord. This is part of any Lenten program. Go to confession and be free to receive graces beyond belief.


