Dear Friends in Christ,



Liturgically, we have entered Ordinary Time. This is a Season that looks at various mysteries surrounding the life of Christ outside of Easter and Christmas. 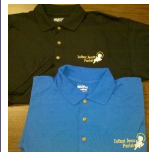
