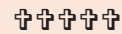

Dear Friends in Christ,



We recently received a letter from the Liturgical Office making observations about how to deal with protection from the flu at Mass. The letter noted that should one be sick, they should consider refraining from Mass. I would caution that having a tickle should not offer us an excuse to miss Holy Mass, but we know when we don't feel well. One could share the sign of peace without touching hands or kissing. It is suggested that a parishioner simply nod your head and wish the person "The peace of Christ." Be assured that we want to insist that Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, let alone priests and deacons, possess hands that are well cleansed before the beginning of Mass. Greeters and we priests may not shake hands at the door. While we are not stopping the distribution of the Blood of Christ, have common sense and avoid the cup if you have a cold or are ill. Remember that one receives the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity under the form of the Sacred Host alone. Receiving from the cup is receiving a fuller "symbol" of the reality. He is truly Present under both or either species. So, please be aware of your health situation, use common sense and be nourished with the life giving Word of God and loving Communion with the Lord.
