We have a Santo Niño in each of our churches! The Alliance of the Two Hearts donated a Santo Niño or Holy Child to our parish and is now in the sanctuary of Saint Margaret Church. He comes to us from Cebu, Philippines. May He bless us all as we also enjoy our beautiful Santo Niño in Saint John Vianney Church on his pedestal at the feet of Saint Joseph. Mabuhay ang Santo Niño! On Wednesday, January 6th our parish celebrates the parish feast day: The Infant Jesus! When our parish was founded in 2010, the Solemnity of the Epiphany of Our Lord was declared as our parish feast day. We will have 24 hours of prayer before the Most Blessed Sacrament beginning January 6th after the 8:30 AM Mass until the next morning at the beginning of the 8:30 AM Mass. There are clipboards for adorers to sign up for holy hours. On the 6th, we will have a Holy Hour at 7:00 PM. All this will take at Saint Margaret Church. Please consider honoring the Holy Infant and start your new year on the right footing. Saint Faustina wrote of one of her mystical experiences of the Infant Jesus: "...I suddenly saw the Infant Jesus standing by my kneeler and holding on to it with His two little hands. Although He was but a little Child, my soul was filled with awe and fear, for I see in Him my Judge, my Lord, and my Creator, before whose holiness the Angels tremble. At the same time, my soul was flooded with such unspeakable love that I thought I would die under its influence" (*Diary*, 566). Oh, if we only understood the love of God, our dear Emmanuel, Who is truly God with us. His love should fill us with such faith, hope and love as we begin this 2016. May our dear, holy Patron grant us all the graces we need to have the best year of our lives because we are closer to Him!

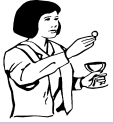

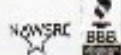

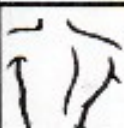
