

to us from Cebu, Philippines. May He bless us all as we also enjoy our beautiful Santo Niño in Saint John Vianney Church on his pedestal at the feet of Saint Joseph. Mabuhay ang Santo Niño! On Wednesday, January 6th our parish celebrates the parish feast day: The Infant Jesus! When our parish was founded in 2010, the Solemnity of the Epiphany of Our Lord was declared as our parish feast day. 


