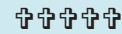

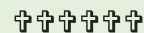

Dear Friends in Christ,



A young woman was killed for no apparent reason in San Francisco while walking along the water. A commentator on the news noted that when someone dies suddenly and tragically, they get a candle, balloon and Teddy Bear laid at the spot of death. The speaker asked if anyone was offering up a prayer for a beautiful life taken. We have a gift in our Catholic faith in that we offer Mass for the soul of the deceased and can have Masses offered for our loved ones and for others who died. The *Catechism* states, "From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic Sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God" (No. 1032). The *Catechism* goes on to say, "The Holy Mass transcends time and space, uniting the faithful in heaven, on earth and in purgatory into a Holy Communion, and the Holy Eucharist itself augments our union with Christ, wipes away venial sins, and presences us from future mortal sins." (*Catechism*, No. 1391-1396). We can never realize the gift of the Holy Mass and the power that comes from participating in Mass and having Mass offered for someone. We do not "buy a Mass", but rather, our monetary offering is our sacrifice in having the Mass offered. The Mass is everything to us and yet, so many Catholics do not attend Mass weakly, have services offered for loved ones rather than have a Funeral Mass offered and ignore the teachings of Holy Scripture with a total smugness. We complain that the Mass does not entertain enough. Saint Josemaria Escriva once commented, "You find the Mass long? It is because your love is short." St. Leonard once exclaimed: "O, poor deceived people, what are you doing? Why do you not crowd the churches in order that you might attend as many Masses as possible? Why do you not take as models the angels who, whenever Mass is being celebrated, descend in legions from Paradise and kneel before the altar in reverence that they may efficaciously intercede for us?" O, blessed Mass...O gift of God!

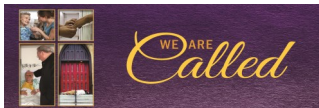
