Dear Friends in Christ,



I believe that it is essential that you know what is happening with your donations and how we spend on facilities. At this time, we are currently changing the electric conduits in Saint

Margaret Church and new lighting is being installed. Kelly Electric was selected to do this work and they are under way, kindly working around our schedule. The roof at Saint Margaret has been a problem for many years and our Buildings and Grounds Committee has been assessing and evaluating the need to totally resurface the roof. It has been patched in different spots to stop the leakage. Recently, we had a presentation on metal roofs offered to Infant Jesus Pastoral Council and to the Finance Council. We received helpful information. It was my intention to have the roof done this summer. Regretfully, we may have run into a new glitch. We were informed that one of the air handler units is shot in Saint Margaret Church and that we are cooling with one lung. There was improvement in the installation of new thermostats, but our system is outdated and could go at any moment. The church was packed for graduation and though set at 68 degrees, it was struggling to get below 76 degrees. Granted, there were a lot of bodies, but it is a dire issue. We can survive some drips that happen when there is extended rain, but if the air conditioning and heating goes, we are in big trouble. Being able to see and atmospheric comfort are more important than the odd drip. The roof will be put on the back burner, but not forgotten. We just found out about this heat/air conditioning problem and thus, do not have a whole lot of information yet. It is being moved upon and we have every hope that while installing a new unit will be very expensive, it will save in the long run in efficiency of fuel and electricity. I am grateful to those parishioners who are assisting me in these temporal matters. Please fill free to speak to me at any time about our situation.


