specific need or perhaps, when we are given a great gift from God, we actually thank Him. We have all learned beautiful rote or memorized prayers such as the Our Father, Hail Mary, etc.; powerful prayers, but dictated by someone else. Rote prayers help us to meditate and pray when we cannot find words. The Lord wants us to speak to Him from the depths of our being. Saint Josemaria Escriva said about discourse with the Lord, "To pray is to talk to God, but about what? About Him, about yourself; joys, sorrows, successes, and failures, noble ambitions, daily worries, weaknesses! And acts of thanksgiving and petitions: and Love and reparation. In a word: to get to know Him and to get to know yourself: to get acquainted." We cannot go long without food or drink or oxygen. Hunger, thirst and weakness tell us: I need it now! Too often, prayer can be a snack or a sip. We need to speak to the Lord every day and frequently. How strong we become when we are in contact with our loving Jesus! We know that our marriages are harmed or other relationships diminish when we do not speak to those whom we love. Why believe that we are disciples of the Lord Jesus when we hardly give Him any time? We can be one in our desire to saddle up next to Jesus speaking about the most intimate things in our lives. Read His living Word every day and be nourished so that conversation with the Lord becomes natural and true. Tell Him everything and listen to Jesus in the deepest recesses of your heart. Search for Him in your center. Saint John of the Cross expresses it so beautifully in his work Living Flame of Love, "O how gently and how lovingly do You lie awake in the depth and center of my soul, where You in secret and in silence alone, as its sole Lord, abides, not only as in Your own house or in Your own chamber, but also as within my own bosom, in close and intimate union."
