As we celebrate Palm Sunday or Passion Sunday we recall our Lord's triumphant entry into Jerusalem that will kick off a week of loving sacrifice to save us from sin and death. The people wave the palms of victory one minute and cry out for His destruction the next. We may look at them wondering how they could do such a thing. In reality, we too wave to Jesus one minute and then push Him out of our lives (if not demanding His crucifixion over and over again). This Lent has been about really looking at ourselves to see where in our lives we have pushed Jesus out. No time to pray...those teachings of the Church are so old fashioned...I can pray anywhere, why go to Mass?...others in the Church are not perfect, they are hypocrites, so why in my perfection should I worship with them?...I really don't sin, so why go to confession? The list is so much longer. "Hosanna to the Son of David" out one side of our mouths and "If You are the Son of God, come down off that Cross" out of the other side. Yes, we hypocrites (which means a false face) need a savior. What a beautiful One we have if we would only truly recognize Him as the Way, the Truth and the Life! Jesus says, "At that time many will turn away from the faith and will betray and hate each other, and many false prophets will appear and deceive many people. Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved." (Matthew 24:10-13). May our very being cry out to the world "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" Yes, we are with You Jesus!

Today, Sunday, Palm begins Holy Week. As Christians. we must contemplate deeply the

highest holy days of the year, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and, of course, Easter. Holy Week is a journey through darkness of the Passion into the light of the Resurrection. Traditionally, this journey has been prayerfully commemorated in two liturgical celebrations: Tenebrae and the Easter Vigil. Everyone can recall the sense of Christ's triumph as the lights come on in glory at the Easter Vigil. Tenebrae, which is Latin for "the shadows," is probably a less familiar experience. It helps us meditate on the darkness of Jesus' Passion and death. It is not a Mass. Rather, Tenebrae is a somber prayer service that involves praying the Psalms, reflecting on Sacred Scripture, and the extinguishing of candles as the church is darkened. Infant Jesus Parish will celebrate Tenebrae at St. Margaret Church at 7:00 PM on Palm Sunday. Please join us. More importantly, join Jesus who says to each of us from Gethsemane: Could you not spend even one hour with me?
