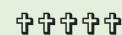

Dear Friends in Christ,



Spring is a beautiful time for marriages. In this grace filled sacrament, a man and a woman give themselves completely to one another in vows before the altar of God. The priest or deacon, along with two witnesses, confirms that a man and woman have promised to be true to each other in good times and in bad; in sickness and in health. Regretfully, we are seeing more and more men and women “living in sin” meaning living as though husband and wife prior to marriage. I know these are harsh words, but they are traditional words. A loving pastor should not weaken the truth. I read on a biblical website recently: “Many say they live together before marriage to see if they are compatible as they don't want to divorce. This may sound like a justifiable reason for committing the sin of fornication, but in God's eyes it is still sin. Statistics however, show that those who live together before marriage are more likely to get a divorce than those who do not. Living together shows a total lack of trust in God and a failure to commit to Him the choosing of a mate. Christians who are living in this situation are out of the will of God and need to repent and seek God as to whether this person is the right one for them. If it is God's will for them to be together they should marry. Otherwise, they need to change their living arrangements.” We need to see a young man and a young woman court appropriately, become engaged, marry and then build a home together. This is God's plan and any other type of arrangements will not receive His blessing. Let us pray for couples who are preparing for marriage that they will live according to God's laws and will make a life long commitment to each other for their own good, for society and the Holy Church.

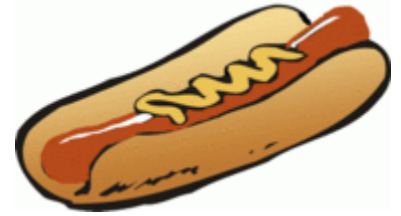
