Dear Friends in Christ,



We now approach the month of November, the time when the Church celebrates in a special way all the Holy Souls who have departed this life and have gone to God. On Monday, November 2, 2015, the Feast of All Souls, our parish will remember those who have died from our parish in the last year. A Mass will begin at 7:00 PM in St. Margaret's Church calling to mind those who have died in the Lord. Please consider attending this Mass even if your loved ones have been dead longer than a year. This Mass will be offered for all of our beloved dead asking God's merciful forgiveness for the sins of those who have died and will ask the Lord to consider the loving deeds carried out by the faithful departed. Since the Mass is the "source and summit" of the Christian Life, we offer the Holy Sacrifice of Mass, the most perfect prayer, for our deceased relatives and friends who may still need the help of our prayers. Priests are strictly obligated to remember the person for whom the Mass is being offered. As you know, the intention for each Mass is listed in the bulletin and announced before the Mass. The envelopes for All Souls Day which are available for your offering will be kept on the altar at every Mass during the entire month of November. Your priests will remember these souls in each of the Masses offered. Father John Hardon, SJ wrote that the "fruits of the Mass are the spiritual and temporal blessings obtained through the Eucharistic sacrifice. The general fruits of the Mass are applied to the whole Church, in which all the faithful share, both the living and the dead. The special fruits are applied first to the priest who celebrates Mass, then to those for whom he offers it, and finally to those who participate in the Eucharistic liturgy." There is no greater gift than to have a Mass said for our departed brethren. *Fidelium animae per misericordiam Dei requiescant in pace (May the souls of the faithful departed through the mercy of God rest in peace).*

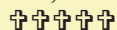

Sunday Evening Talk: “Come to the Father!”

While on the way to his martyrdom in the year 107 A.D., St. Ignatius of Antioch wrote a letter to the Christians of Rome saying: “There is living water in me which speaks and says inside me, ‘Come to the Father.’” The fruit of Christian baptism is to know that your heavenly Father loves you not because you’re good but because He is good (St. Thomas Aquinas).

Scripture for Reflection: *Luke 12:29-32*

Monday Evening Talk: “Christ Crucified”

In a world where success is everything, where winning the gold medal is all that counts and 2nd place is for losers, we are often crushed by frequent failures, signs of weakness and patterns of sin. Jesus Christ’s death on the Cross is the supreme sign of the Father’s love for us and the only true pathway to our own glorious transformation as children of God.

Scripture for Reflection: *Romans 8:31-36, 37-39*

Tuesday Evening Talk: “Fire It Up!”

Jesus Christ came to set the earth on fire with the truth of God’s love. On the day of Pentecost power came down from heaven which enabled the disciples to communicate their experience of the risen Lord to anyone who would listen. In the words of Bl. John Paul II: “When we meet Christ and accept His gospel, life changes and we are driven to communicate our experience to others.”

Scripture for Reflection: *2 Timothy 1:6-8*

Wednesday Evening Homily during Mass: “Eucharistic Amazement”

In his last encyclical on the Holy Eucharist, Pope John Paul II wrote: “The Eucharist, as Christ’s saving presence in the community of the faithful and its spiritual food, is the most precious possession which the Church can have in her journey through history.” St. Thomas Aquinas taught that “no other sacrament has greater healing power.” Our Eucharistic Amazement is not complete until it moves us to lead people to discover the Real Presence of Jesus Christ on earth in the Sacraments of His Church.
