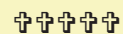

Dear Friends in Christ,



The Synod on the Family continues to take place in Rome with Cardinals, Bishops, Theologians and Laity discussing the family at this very challenging time in the world. Across the board, there is a great deal of confusion about what makes a family, what are the ways to create a family and how does faith sustain the family? An interesting commentary on the synod posed the question: Would the Church, by compromising on traditional teachings, be walking with the family into further darkness or should the Church walk with families leading them to conversion? As always, I believe we need to look to Our Lord and the Gospels for the answer. Jesus always met people where they were in life, but an encounter with Him always led to a new life. Jesus would heal and forgive, but He would always say, "Go and sin no more." This must be our pattern. Sin is a sin, it does not vary from person to person. Either an action is right or wrong; if we love someone we do not simply leave them in the darkness. Of course, there must never be force or coercion, but rather the joy of the Truth is what convinces people. As the Synod unfolds, personally, I pray that the bar is not lowered, but rather that all of us would be inspired to live out our life in truth which has been "made in the image and likeness of God." It is so important that we lift up the hearts of the broken to see the love of God in all its splendor and truth!
