As you read this letter, Father Chris and I will have been on the annual Presbyteral Convocation gathering with the Bishop in Avalon. Youth Group

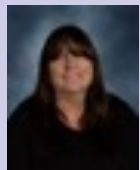
Halloween—there will be no youth group Saturday, October 31 due to Halloween.
