This weekend, the Office of Vocations for the Diocese of Camden is hosting an event called: *iRace4Vocations*. This is a 5K run/1.5 mile walk to raise awareness of the need for priestly and



religious vocations. How great to see priests, deacons and sisters in habit witnessing to a love for Jesus. A true blessing is to have our bishop with us. He is the celebrant of the Mass and remains until the end encouraging those present to pray for and to consider saying "yes" to a call from God. The Holy Father, Pope Francis, spoke to the faithful in a Sunday Angelus talk, "Youth must be placed at the service of great ideals. Do you think so? Do you agree? Ask Jesus what he wants of you and be courageous! Be courageous! Ask him! Behind and prior to every vocation to the priesthood or the consecrated life there is always someone's powerful and intense prayer: a grandmother's, a grandfather's, a mother's, a father's, a community's; This is why Jesus said: "Pray to the Lord of the harvest," that is, God the Father, "that he might send workers for the harvest!" As your pastor, I ask you disciples of Jesus to encourage vocations, especially to the Priesthood, by praying to the Lord, speaking well of priests in your life and should you see the qualities of a good priest in a young man, tell him so. Encourage him to say yes and begin praying for his discernment by making a visit to the Blessed Sacrament, praying the Rosary or offering a sacrifice for him. The Holy Spirit is making His presence known...catch the fire and spread it. Always remember: No priests then no Eucharist and then no Church. Pray for your priests that we will be an example that will inspire men to follow in our footsteps.
