Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

In today's Gospel, someone asked Jesus: "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" Jesus replied: "Try to come in through the narrow door. Many, I tell you, will try to enter and unable." The person who posted the question was asking a wrong question. To be saved or not to be saved is not a decision to



be made by Jesus; it is our choices, our free wills, and our decisions. God created us with free will to choose for ourselves heaven or hell. God does not put anyone in heaven or hell; but rather, through Jesus' suffering and death on the cross, He opens the gate of heaven, making it possible for us to enter and also, due to sin entering the world, He allowed the existence of hell. Indeed Jesus has desired all and not few to be saved by ushering us to the way of salvation, as He said: "Try to come in through the narrow door". What is the "narrow door" especially at our time? The "narrow door" is the "door" that is not popular, not "everyone is willing to enter it, not everyone is willing to do it". If Jesus comes to our time today, first He would tell the young people that: "come in through the narrow door by putting your iphone down, talk and not text your parents, moving away from the computer and having personal touch and contact with your parents, getting to know your next door neighbor's name instead of communicating with people around the world whom you have never met, seeking fulfillment in the truths of Jesus' teachings and not in the deceptive things of this world". Secondly, to all of us whether we are religious, laity, parents, grandparents, children, brothers, sisters, or friends, Jesus would tell each one of us that "your narrow door is trying to fulfill your mission which I entrusted to you from the beginning of your creation, sharing and bearing the physical, mental and even moral burdens of your loved ones and others, being in touch with me everyday through your prayers, accepting my will for you in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health, don't turn away from me but rather fixing your eyes upon me always, and everyday learning to recognize my divine presence and my providential care in your lives and in the lives of those who you encounter. These are the "narrow doors" which are not popular, not everyone would have the patient perseverance to enter or the faithfulness to get through. "Many, I tell you, will try to enter and unable". However, with the help of God the Holy Spirit and with Jesus Christ as our Companion, we will be able to get through the "narrow door" of our - Father Joe Pham, Pastor time.
