In August, our parish sent Deacon Frank and his wife Dianne Dunleavy to Pittsburg for one intensive training week for the Stephen Ministry. The name of this ministry is derived from the name of the first Deacon in the Book of the Acts of the Apostles. According to chapter 6 of the Acts of the Apostles, after the ascension of Jesus Christ, the Apostles gathered the people together as a community of faith which is also considered as a primitive church. Due to the great number of the faithful, the spiritual and corporal cares were in a great demand. For this reason, the Apostles appointed Stephen as a Deacon to oversee the distribution of food and specially to make sure the widows and orphans in the community were physically and spiritually being cared for. Inspired by St. Stephen's caregiving and the enormous pastoral demands of our time, the Stephen Ministry was established by Rev. Kenneth Haug in 1975 in St. Louis, Missouri. The mission of this Ministry is to provide one-on-one Christian care to individuals who are facing a variety of crises in their lives such as grief, divorce, cancer, financial difficulties, hospitalization, chronic illness, job loss, disabilities, loneliness, spiritual crisis, or other life struggles. For this good and noble cause, I would like to invite everyone to take a prayerful reflection and to consider joining this Ministry. Jesus needs you, the Church needs you, and our parish needs you to use your God-given gifts and blessings to bring comfort, consolation, healing, peace, and loving care to our hurting and suffering brothers and sisters. "Blessed are those who are merciful, for they will be shown mercy". Deacon Frank will share with us more about this Ministry in the future during Masses.
