Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

It is only a few days away that we, together with the whole Church, will joyfully celebrate the mystery of the Incarnation of the Son of God, Jesus Christ. In today's Gospel, the focus is on God's salvific plan for St. Joseph, the spouse of Mary and the foster father of Jesus, God's incarnate Son.



The New Testament does not give us much information about St. Joseph except his righteousness. As today's Gospel wrote: "Joseph her husband, since he was a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame, decided to divorce her quietly." When finding out Mary was pregnant, instead of feeling betrayed and looking for a way to revenge, St Joseph decided not to accuse her before the law which would lead Mary to death by stoning for the "sin of adultery". His virtue of righteousness made St. Joseph not to revenge but leave "condemnation" into God's hands. Let all men, all husbands and fathers learn from St. Joseph's righteousness by being more loving, caring, tolerating and forgiving. We should always give our loved ones a second chance rather than push them to an end. St. Joseph gave Mary a chance to live, Jesus gave us a chance to change, so let us give our loved ones a chance to start over again especially during this Holy Season, the Season of love, Joy, and Peace. - *Fr. 
