Dear Sisters and Brothers of Infant Jesus Family,



On December 8, together with the whole Church, we will joyfully celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of Jesus and our Mother. God had chosen her from the very beginning to be His first disciple and Mother of His Incarnate Son Jesus Christ. From the moment of her conception, God sanctified her, freed her from the stain of the original sin, so that His Son Jesus Christ would have an immaculate dwelling place in the womb of Mary. The Immaculate Conception of Mary is not something alienated to human nature; but rather, from the beginning, God created humanity in the state of holiness, free from the stain of sin. Mary was chosen and was brought back to that original state of human nature intended by God. God the Father would have never let His Son to be born in a womb contracted with any stain of sin, also God the Son would have never let His Mother, the one who bore Him in her womb, undergo death which is the consequence of original sin. The reason for Mary to be chosen as the Mother of God's Son is that because she was the best of the best among women. God could not find any woman, except Mary, who was completely submissive to His divine will. When Mary said: "Let it be done to me according to your words", she surrendered her whole being to God's will, she was ready to accept all the consequences entailed. As children of Mary, we need to learn from Mary, our Mother, her model of faith. We should remind ourselves everyday the "Prayer of Mary, let it be done to me according to your will", the prayer which her Son Jesus also learned and prayed in the agony garden. Christmas Pageant

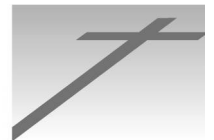

Holy Land Christians*

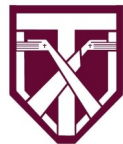

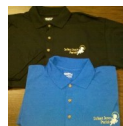
